



## **Gov. Perry Appoints Edwards to Texas Lottery Commission**

Gov. Rick Perry has appointed Veronica Edwards of San Antonio to the Texas Lottery Commission for a term to expire Feb. 1, 2017. The commission oversees the Texas Lottery, and ensures lottery and bingo games are conducted in a legal and fair manner.

Edwards is founder and CEO of InGenesis Inc. She is a member of the University of the Incarnate Word Board of Trustees, corporate recruitment chair for the San Antonio Chapter of the American Diabetes Association, and a board member of the Texas Women's Forum and the World Affairs Council of San Antonio. She was named by Inc. Magazine as a Top 10 Female CEO in 2012, and named the nation's top Latina Businesswoman by the U.S. Hispanic Chamber of Commerce in 2011.

Edwards received a bachelor's degree from Southwest Texas State University, now Texas State University, and a Master of Business Administration from the University of the Incarnate Word, where she is currently pursuing a doctorate of human resources and organizational leadership.

This appointment is subject to Senate confirmation.
